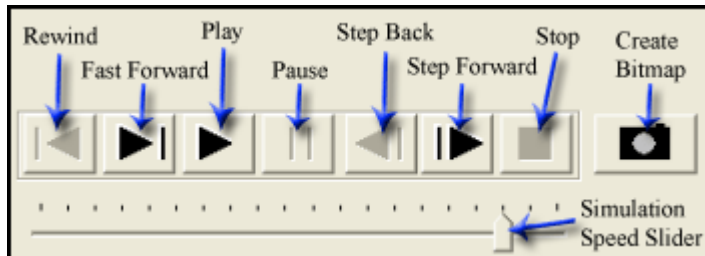


The Simulation Viewer Buttons

In this thread, we will show you what each of the buttons in the simulation viewer do. If you haven't already, view the thread called "[The Simulation Tab](#)" in order to understand how to get to the viewer and how to adjust some of its settings.

Let's take a closer look at the buttons underneath the simulation window.



"Rewind" will move the simulation back to the very beginning.

"Fast Forward" will move the simulation to the very end.

"Play" will begin playing the simulation with the current settings and at the current speed.

"Pause" will pause the simulation at its current location.

"Step Back" will move the simulation back one frame per click (this only works while the simulation is paused or stopped).

"Step Forward" will move the simulation forward one frame per click (this only works while the simulation is paused or stopped).

"Stop" will stop the simulation at its current location.

The **"Create Bitmap"** button will bring up the "Save As" window and allow you to save a bitmap image of the currently displayed frame.

The slider at the bottom will dynamically adjust the speed at which the simulation plays.
